# **Position Description**

Position: Library Services Coordinator

Tenure: Three years

## **Role Purpose:**

The Library Services Coordinator is responsible for delivering high quality library services by creating opportunities through program, learning spaces, research services and experiences to the school community.

# **Key Responsibilities:**

# **Education in Faith**

- Support and participate in the faith life of the College including a commitment to the Mission Statement and ethos of the College.
- Assist staff and students to develop their sense of belonging as members of the school through
  participation in rituals and celebrations that foster the development of a relationship with each
  other, with God and with the community.
- Encourage the College community to bring the Salesian charism to life and promote the Salesian values.
- Implement the Salesian pedagogy of learning through relationship and presence based on reason, religion and loving kindness.

#### **Leading Learning and Teaching**

- Provide experiences for students that encourage reading, literacy and information usage.
- Have a professional involvement in the learning and teaching program of the school by collaborating with teachers in curriculum development and implementation.
- Participate in the teaching of digital literacy.
- Engage and challenge learners within a supportive, information-rich learning environment.
- The Library Services Coordinator will have an appropriate teaching load in negotiation with the Principal (if applicable).

## **Developing Self and Others**

- Assist in equipping students with the skills and tools needed to be effective online citizens.
- To provide students with the skills to be information literate, using information to solve problems, evaluate information and be confident creators of content.
- Provide support and assistance to teachers in the effective use of Information and Communication Technologies.

• Encouraging literacy development and lifelong learning by engaging students in reading, viewing and listening for understanding and enjoyment.

## **Leading Innovation and Change**

- Create a stimulating, helpful and welcoming environment for students, including showcasing student learning achievements.
- Resource curriculum programs and assessment which incorporate transferable information literacy and literature outcomes.
- Facilitates access to external sources of information.
- Collaboratively work with the IT Team to implement needed library IT infrastructure for teaching and learning.
- The direction, deployment and management of all library staff.

#### **Leading the Management of the School**

- Management of the acquisitions policy and appropriate liaison with Subject Learning Leaders.
- Managerial responsibility to ensure that the collection in text and electronic form is consistent with the ethos of the College.
- Understands copyright, fair use, and licensing of intellectual property, and assisting users with their understanding and observance of the same.
- Develop and monitor library policies, procedures, systems and team rosters to ensure that the day-to-day operations, staffing and administration of all library spaces is both effective and efficient
- Encourage regular lunchtime activities.
- Administer the library budget including the purchase and maintenance of textbooks.

# **Engaging and Working with the Community**

- To maintain an atmosphere in the facility which assists the conduct of independent study & research
- Where appropriate attend curriculum meetings and join curriculum committees.
