# **Dear Parents and Guardians**

Nagle College aims to provide innovative, inclusive, and engaging educational pathways that enable students to develop their potential to become lifelong learners. We do this through the provision of a diverse curriculum which delivers a quality Catholic educational experience. The richness of this experience is largely a function of our staff and the school's available physical resources. Income is provided by government grants, and by our families through the student fees.

When setting the fees for the 2024 school year, the following are considered:

- The financial input required to provide students with access to curriculum pathways offered by Nagle.
- Expected Government Grant Income.
- The operational and capital costs required to maintain and develop the College into the future.
- The local economic environment.

#### **Fee Structure**

The College fee structure consists of an annual tuition charge that includes many costs associated with your child/children's education. These costs include tuition fees, resources and reference materials, College administration, Retreats and Junior Camps, and VCE including Vocational Major subjects among other things. There are also additional fees added such as laptop hire and VET subjects.

# **Discounts and Concessions**

Families with multiple students attending the College are provided with a discounted 'Family Fee' in recognition of the additional costs of raising larger families. In addition, discounts are provided for early payment and structured payment via direct debit.

A per-student concession for families who have a student eligible to receive the Camps Sports Excursion Fund was introduced in 2018. A copy of the Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund (CSEF) Application is attached. For 2024 this concession has been increased to the following amounts:

#### **Total Family Concession Amount (2024)**

Single Student eligible \$ 1,949
Two Students eligible \$ 3,028
Three or more students eligible \$ 3,625

## Financial Hardship/Fee Remission

I encourage any families who are experiencing hardship in meeting their school fee commitments to contact either myself or the College's Business Manager to discuss the options available to them. In circumstances of financial hardship, a reduction in the amount of school fees payable (fee remission) may be considered upon receipt of a written application from the parents.
