At Nagle College, we are proud to offer an enriching Instrumental Music Program designed to cultivate independent, creative, and skilled musicians. We recognize and value the numerous benefits of instrumental music education, which can enhance students' engagement with school, promote personal and social growth, and support overall academic success. Music education at Nagle may also provide future career pathways and add lifelong value.



MUSIC BURSARY

Available to students learning select brass or woodwind instrument. The bursary provides financial assistance from the college to help cover the cost of lessons.

Lesson Fees: Shared or group lessons are capped at \$70 per term.

Payment Process: Your child's Music Tutor will invoice you directly for \$70 each term, with payment details included on the invoice.

Duration: The bursary allocation lasts for one school year.

Instrument Provision: An instrument will be allocated at the first lesson at no cost.

Terms & Conditions

Invoice Payment: Payment of invoices issued by music tutors is expected within 3 weeks. If payments are delayed or withheld, the tutor may cease lessons, and the bursary allocation may be withdrawn.

Practice Expectations: As the school provides financial assistance, students are expected to undertake regular home practice.

NON-BURSARY INSTRUMENTS

For guitar, piano, drum kit, and percussion, fees are negotiated directly with music tutors.

Lesson Options and Costs: Individual and group lessons are optional for all instruments except piano. Indicative costs are:

- Shared lesson: \$24
- Individual lesson: \$35



BAND PARTICIPATION

All students may participate in groups such as the guitar group, concert bands, and percussion groups.

LESSON TIMETABLING

Music lessons may be scheduled as either 29-minute or 58-minute sessions on a rotational basis according to the timetable.
